









## Nursery - Year 6 Homework Expectations

<b>Reading</b> 	Sharing books and reading together.	Sharing books and reading together. <b>From Autumn 2:</b> high frequency word reading each week, 1 reading book, twice a week.	Reading for 20 minutes per day. This will be recorded in a reading journal and signed by an adult. Reading records will be checked and books will be changed on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.					
<b>Maths</b> 			Number bonds/Number facts/Times table practise. <b>Sent home on a Monday, tested on Friday.</b>	Children will be given an overview at the beginning of the half term, which outlines the times table that they need to practise at home each week. <b>The children will then have a times tables test on a Friday.</b> 				
<b>Spelling</b> 		Learning letter sounds each week.	 Children will be given an overview at the beginning of the half term, which outlines the spellings that they need to practice at home each week. <b>The children will have a spelling test on a Friday.</b>					
<b>Topic</b> 			To reinforce the learning carried out in school, <b>children will be expected to carry out one piece of topic homework a half term.</b> They will be provided with ideas but can also choose their own idea. These will be on display for parents to see after our termly learning assemblies. 					
<b>Vocabulary Development</b> 	Weekly launchpad talk homework.		Each half term, families will be given a <b>'family talk homework'</b> where they will be asked to talk about a given topic. There will then be an opportunity for parents and carers to join the children for a special celebratory assembly to share what they have talked about.
