Be ready to learn:

Value Learning:

- I will motivate and encourage my child to do their best and learn from their mistakes.

Be a role model:

- I will build a positive and supportive relationship with the school.
- Show the behaviour I want to see e.g. have good manners- say please and thank you.
- Be on time for collection, meetings, assemblies etc.
- Follow the school code of conduct.
- Take part in learning myself. Letting my child see me read and attending school workshops.
