- Dividing numbers



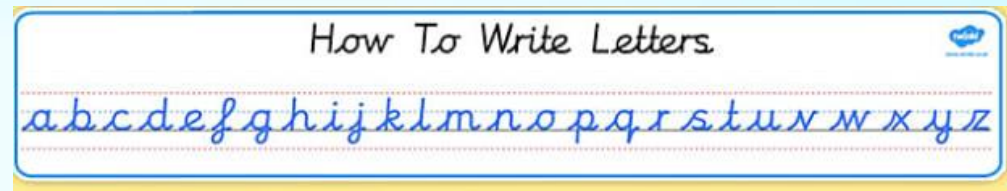
# Writing in Y3
