

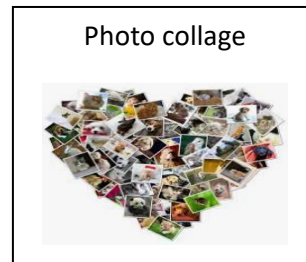
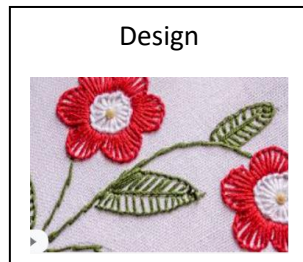
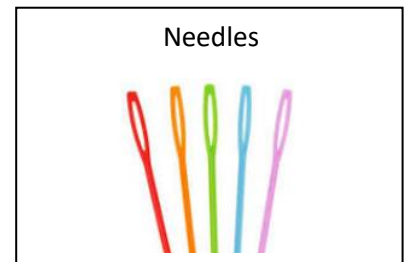

Fabric	Cloth of other material produced by weaving or knitting.
Cutting	The action of cutting or trimming something.
Stitching	A row of stitches sewn on to cloth.
Needle	A very fine piece of metal with a point at one end and a hole for thread at the other used for sewing.
String	A piece of thread of cotton or other material twisted together to form a thin length.
Collage	A piece of art made by sticking various different materials together to present an art piece.
Design	A plan or drawing to show the look of something you aiming to produce.
Seam	The fold line made by sewing together or joining two edges or two pieces of material.
Technique	A way of carrying out a particular task, an approach.
Identity	A fact of being who or what a person or thing is.
Environment	Everything surrounding you
Threading	To guide a piece of thread through the needle.
