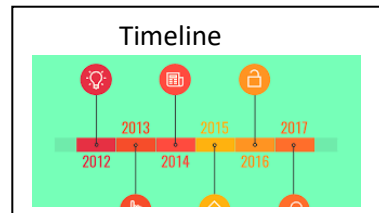
Continents
