

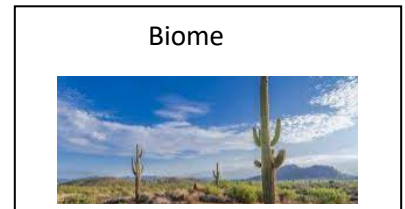
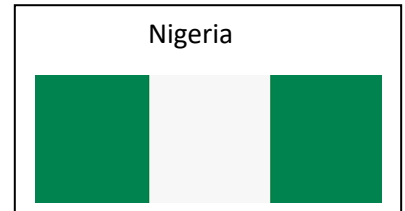

Contrast	The state of being strikingly different from something else.

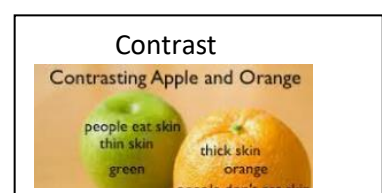
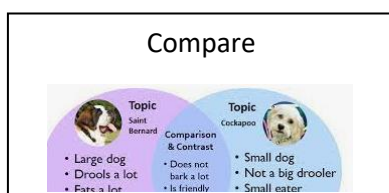
