

**Key Vocabulary**

Plant	Plants are living things that usually rooted in the ground or live in water. Unlike animals, they cannot move from place to place.
Weed	A weed is a wild plant that grows in gardens or fields of crops and prevents the plants from growing properly.
Similar	Having the same qualities, or having qualities in common.
Pollen	Pollen is a substance that causes plants to form seeds. A grain of pollen is so tiny that it is best viewed through a microscope.
Roots	A root is a part of a plant usually hidden underground. Roots take water and food from the soil.
Stem	A stem the body of a plant. It support leaves, flowers and fruits. The stem transports water and other substances to the roots and shoots.
Deciduous	A plant that shed its leaves annually.
Evergreen	A plant that retains green leaves throughout the year.

Trunk	A thick main stem of a plant not including the branches and roots.

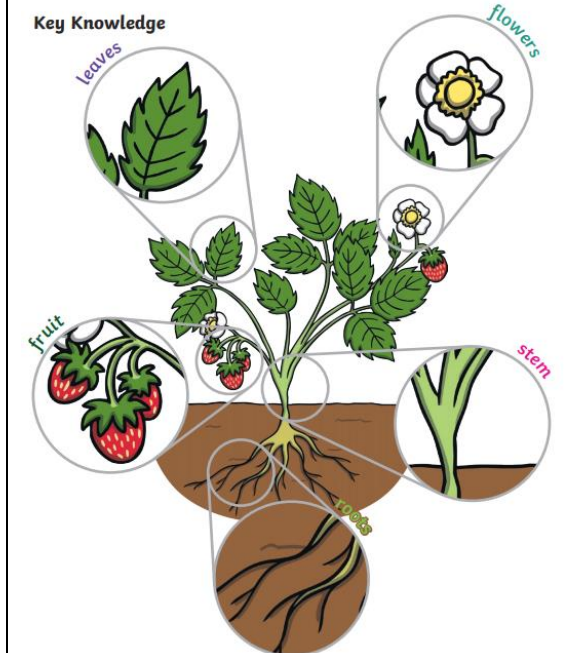
