

## Parent/Carer Feedback - November 2025

42 parents/carers completed the survey (27% of families). The results are overwhelmingly positive.

- 98% strongly agreed/agreed that their child is happy at Harrington Hill.
- 98% strongly agreed/agreed that their child feels safe at school.
- 98% strongly agreed/agreed that staff listen to their child and treat them with respect.
- 98% strongly agreed/agreed that the school promotes respect and kindness among pupils.
- 93% strongly agreed/agreed that since the school grew in September, the staff have helped new pupils and families settle in well.
- 93% strongly agreed/agreed/NA that the school provides appropriate support for pupils with SEND
- 93% strongly agreed/agreed that when concerns are raised, the school deals with them promptly and effectively.
- 98% strongly agreed/agreed that they feel well informed by the school about what their child is learning throughout the year.
